#### Novice/Intermediate Level Workshop Goals:

1. Gain confidence in where to execute you crosses;
2. Readily identify the front-cross/rear-cross line;
3. Gain confidence in providing appropriate cues for your dog when performing a cross; and
4. Develop a series of exercises to perfect the execution and timing of crosses and the dog's understanding.

#### Advanced Level Workshop Goals:

1. Investigate which cues are most pertinent to your dog;
2. Uncover issues in the dog's current understanding;
3. Practice handling jump configurations to strengthen dog and handler confidence;
4. Analyze how to use these skills to solve tricky course situations; and
5. Identify additional techniques to learn and/or optimization of ones already in place.
