Crating available:

There is limited indoor. Outdoor crating at your vehicle is recommended.

Entry Limits:

This trial is limited to 500 runs per day.

Move ups:

Move-ups are allowed from day to day. No same day Move-ups.

Day of show Entries:

Accepted at full price, if the trial is not full.

Refunds:

After the closing date, no entry fees will be refunded for dogs pulled from the Trial with the following exceptions:

If you are ill with any symptoms associated with COVID-19 after the closing date or during the trial, we will refund your entry at any time, minus a small service fee of equal to \$2 per run entered.

Bitches that come into season after the trial closes will receive a 50% refund of entry fees.

Containerized Trial

All food and toys must be contained at the trial.

No food or toys may be left lying about loose.

This includes crating areas. This policy has been implemented to reduce the possibility of dogs fighting over food or toys, diminish dogs rushing with their handlers back to their reward, and minimize the insects around loose food.

Food info:

Awards and Ribbons:

First through Fourth place ribbons will be awarded for each jump height in Intro, Novice, Open and Elite levels. Proficient and Skilled categories will be combined for placement purposes. Qualifying ribbons will be awarded for each qualifying run. There are no placements for Chances - only qualifiers.

Equipment info:

All equipment meets NADAC standards. The A-frame and Dog Walk have rubber surfaces. Weave poles have 24" spacing.

Dogs which require measuring:

Dogs in the Proficient Category, Novice, Open or Elite jumping 4", 8", 12" or 16"

Dogs which do not need to be measured:

Dogs jumping 16" in the Veteran or Junior Handler Division Dogs jumping 20"
Dogs in the Skilled Category
Dogs with a permanent height card
Dogs listed on the Height Exemption List

JUMP HEIGHTS

There are four Standard Division-Proficient jump heights: 8", 12", 16", and 20".

There are four Standard Division-Skilled jump heights: 4", 8", 12", and 16".

There are four jump heights for the Veterans and Junior Handler divisions: 4", 8", 12", and 16".

Brief Summary of Rules:

Please refer to www.nadac.com for a full explanation of all NADAC rules and up to date information.

- Please note that NADAC trials should provide a safe and fun environment for both exhibitors and their dogs.
- Aggressive dogs will not be tolerated and will be excused from the trial.
- The show committee has the right to refuse any entry. Anyone not currently in good standing with NADAC will not be allowed to enter this trial.
- Exhibitors, through submission of entry, acknowledge that they are knowledgeable of NADAC rules and regulations, and agree to abide by all rules in effect at the time of this trial.
- No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reasons of riots, civil
 disturbances, fire, acts of God, public emergency, an act of a public enemy, or any other cause
 beyond the control of the organizing committee.
- Checks not honored by the bank do not constitute a valid entry fee. There will be a \$30.00 service charge for bank returned checks.
- Dog must be registered and have a valid registration number before entries will be accepted. https://www.nadac.com/register-your-dog/
- A copy of the current Exhibitors Handbook may be downloaded free from the NADAC web site: www.nadac.com
- Bitches in heat, lame, or blind dogs are ineligible for entry, as is any dog with a deformity which
 may cause a judge to not be able to reasonably assess the dog's ability to function and
 perform agility obstacles safely, and in a manner that is in the best interest, health and welfare
 of the dog.
- No food, clickers, or other aids or devices shall be permitted on the course or within 10 feet of the ring. Food or a small non-audible toy can be in a secure container (Ziplock bag is acceptable) in your pocket during your run, but it cannot be used during your run, nor can you indicate to the dog it is there. All handlers may bring a non-audible toy into the ring for training purposes. They cannot earn a Qualifying score and must declare to the judge they are training before they commence their run. Please read the Exhibitor's Handbook for more information about toys and training in the ring.
- The sponsoring clubs will not be responsible for the loss or damage to any dog
 exhibited, or for the possessions of any exhibitor whether the result be accident or
 other cause. It is distinctly understood that every dog at this event is in the care and
 control of his owner or handler during the entire time the dog is on the show premises.

- 1.1. As used here "NADAC" means the North American Dog Agility Council, LLC., its members, officers, directors, employees, show chairs, show committees and agents.
- 1.2. Exhibitor/owner agree to abide by the rules and regulations of NADAC and any other rules and regulations appearing in the premium for this event.
- 1.3. Exhibitor/owner certify that the entered dog is not a hazard to persons, dogs or property and that the entered dog's rabies vaccination is current in accordance with the requirement of the state in which the dog resides.
- 1.4. Exhibitor/owner acknowledge all hazards presented by the event and the event premises, including, but not limited to, the condition of the surface, restrooms, security measures or lack of, electrical appliances, fittings, show rings, parking areas and the presence of unfamiliar animals and people; exhibitor and owner assume the risk of any harm arising from these.
- 1.5. Exhibitor/owner releases NADAC (including its respective officers, directors, employees, and members), WHAT (including its officers, directors, members, and event organizing committee) and BE Canines LLC (including its officers, agents, and employees) and will defend them and hold them harmless from all present and future loss, injury, damage, claims, demands and liabilities involving the entered dog, the event or event premises. Without limiting the generality of the foregoing hold harmless provisions, exhibitor/owner hereby specifically assumes sole responsibility for and agrees to indemnify and save the aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expenses (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damages because of bodily injuries, including death, at any time in consequence of my (our) participation in this event, howsoever such injury or death may be caused and whether or not the same may have been caused or may have been alleged to have been caused by negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees or agents or any other persons.
